ASCP will conduct a *Grey Card* (Pavements) course at Rydges Parramatta on 11 September. Rydges Parramatta is readily accessible from the M4, Parramatta Road and Victoria Road which all provide access to James Ruse Drive. There is ample carparking available.

This course is intended for individuals or organisations with only small numbers of employees requiring training. For organisations with approximately 20 – 40 people requiring the course, ASCP will provide a course at their required location.

The course commences at 8.00 am (registration from 7.45 am) and finishes at 4.00 pm. Morning tea and lunch is provided. At the completion of the training, each attendee will be required to complete an assessment questionnaire. Successful completion of this questionnaire is a requirement in order to receive the 'Statement of Completion' of the course, and the 'Grey Card'.
