### **ABOUT THIS FORUM**

With an eye to future rehabilitation solutions **John Hodgkinson** will re-visit a **CRCP overlay** constructed on the Hume Highway, just north of Holbrook, in 1992.

A significant milestone was reached in June 2021 as the first BCSA Rapid Set Concrete slab celebrated its 10th Birthday in Australia at Sydney International Airport. Since this time, Antoun has been involved in the replacement and delivery of 100's of slabs supplying more than 10,000m<sup>3</sup> of BCSA Rapid Set Concrete to many concrete roads, Motorways and airports throughout Australia and internationally. **Ian Hampton** will review the technical findings from these slab replacements including results from samples from the last decade.

Zahid Hoque from TfNSW will be presenting on pavement performance data collection in NSW. Zahid will discuss the current approach to pavement data collection on the TfNSW network, along with a discussion on application in pavement maintenance and upgrades.

The **Annual General Meeting** will be held following the forum presentations, with all members encouraged to participate.

Following the AGM the ASCP Inaugural Awards for Technical Excellence will be held. Justin Moss will open the program providing his President's Update and introduce our keynote speaker for the event is Camilla Drover, who as the Deputy Secretary, Infrastructure and Place at TfNSW.
