ABOUT THIS FORUM

Innovation, Sustainability, Low Carbon Concretes: How can we achieve in Pavements – has become a keenly anticipated event for 2022. The Australian cement and concrete sector has a long history of reducing its CO2 emissions having delivered a 25 per cent reduction since 2000 [VDZ 2022] which is a critical material input for durable and cost effective concrete pavements.

The **goal for this forum** is to bring together key participants within the **concrete pavement** supply chain and understand the challenges, drivers, tools and possible pathways towards decarbonising cement, concrete and accordingly increasing the competitive advantage of concrete pavements.

Ross Guppy (Austroads) and Richard Edwards (RIE Professional Services) will kick-off with an insight into Austroads National Technical Specification Project. Ken Lunty (Arcadis) and Brook Hall (ARRB) will share perspectives on evolving pavement sustainability assessment tools with Dr Jason Nairn (CCAA) highlighting a recent report road-mapping pathways for the Decarbonisation of the Cement and Concrete Industry for Concrete Pavements.

The afternoon session we return with Jason Chandler (Boral) providing an insight into product innovation process, Justin Moss (Arcadis) presents the award winning sustainable pavement design project, Craig Heidrich (ADAA,ASA,APozA) on the important role of SCM supply chains and Dr Stephen Rae (QTMR) will present the NACoE report findings on recycled aggregates with Sam Henwood (TfNSW) providing us with a State Road update.
