ABOUT THIS FORUM

The August 2023 ASCP Pavement Technical Forum will feature 7 speakers across the full spectrum of the concrete paving industry, with topics as widely varied.

The morning sessions will see **Nandini Mehta** (NATSPEC) present on specifications for concrete pavement in local roads, followed by an exploration of SCMs in construction by **Dr Daksh Baweja** (BG&E).

Mike Auty (AECOM) will present on lessons learned during a recent Crack and Seat/Rubblisation trial in QLD. **Xavier Delattre** (Twintec Australia) will inform the audience of an innovative product, utilising recycled tyre steel to produce steel fibres for pavements.

Following a networking lunch, **David Farah** (Adbri) will provide an update on the development of Type GL cement.

Kerolos Kodous (Madewell Products) will help explore the world of GFRP supply, before **Jamie Egan** (Acciona) closes out our speakers, with a lessons learned presentation of the use of cast in loops on the Northern Connector project.
