ABOUT THIS FORUM

The March 2024 ASCP Pavement Technical Forum will feature 8 speakers across the full spectrum of the concrete paving industry, with topics as widely varied.

The morning sessions will see Anna-Carin Brink (BG&E) give a summary as well as conference highlights of the 14th EUPAVE International Symposium, followed by an investigation and comparison study of primes and strength in concrete by Dr Hamidreza Sahebzaani (SAMI Biumen Technologies).

Craig Heidrich and Jamie Egan (ASCP) will then present the Annual General Meeting, followed by a presentation on Low Carbon Concrete by Craig Heidrich (ADAA), which will lead into La networking lunch.
