Matthias Müller is primarily a construction materials expert with special focus on concrete technology and durability. He has experience in the construction of airfields and motorways in Germany.

He currently holds the position of Managing director of BMC Building Materials Consult GmbH, and Postdoctoral researcher at Bauhaus-University Weimar, Germany.

Matthias is involved with the German Road and Transport Association (FGSV e.V.). He is active on many Working Committees covering construction materials, exposed aggregate pavement concrete, cement application and test standards for pavement concrete.

Matthias recently received an award by the German Road and Transport Association for his contribution to the German concrete pavement sector. This award is linked to a grant to report on experiences from the concrete pavement industry outside Germany. He has chosen to report on the Australian experiences, noting many major construction projects have been carried out here recently. Furthermore, the use of novel materials, such as geopolymers is of special interest.
