The June 2025 ASCP Pavement Technical Forum will feature speakers across the full spectrum of the concrete paving industry, with topics as widely varied.

The morning sessions will see Jun So (Arcadis) deliver an update on the Design and Construction Challenges of SFCP for Coffs Harbour Bypass Project followed by Priyam Thakkar (Ferrovia-Gamuda JV) discussing a Contractors Perspective of CHBP SFCP which will lead into morning tea.
